Cranford

(Frylustre) 2008

It's a gorgeous and enchanting carmine-pink with large supremely elegant blooms, that are large and full and in the classic style with a pleasing perfume. They are borne singly and in clusters on a very tough and vigorous plant that has excellent resistance to disease.

Grows to 30"/80cms.

"Cranford", the novel by Elizabeth Gaskell about life in the mid 1850's in a fictional Cheshire market town is based on her own experiences of growing up in Fryer's Home town of Knutsford

Claret

(Frykristal) 2005 Large black buds open to reveal the darkest colored crimson blooms beautifully formed with sumptuous velvety textured petals. They are scented and carried, boldly erect in well-spaced trusses on a neat, bushy growing plant of medium height. Good in all weathers with an impressive resistance to disease.



Of all the introductions the dark red Hybrid Teas generate the greatest interest and Claret is already establishing itself in the rose world and will become a big customer favorite. Grows to 85cms.



Sparkle

(Frymerlin) 2009 An astonishing newcomer with brilliant, sparkling golden-orange flowers - so bright they glow! As well as being large, they are impeccably formed and carried boldly on erect stems with the abundance of a floribunda. The blooms have a good fragrance, hold their colour well and are unaffected by weather. Growth is strong and vigorous with luxurious, dark green foliage and impressive disease resistance. This is a real spellbinder that will not only liven up the dullest border, but is guaranteed to delight!

Grows to 90cms.

The Wainwright Rose

(Frylovely) 2008 A formidable Hybrid Tea with long elegantly formed buds that slowly unfurl to form large and flawless high centred blooms of fresh pale lemon. They are carried on strong, stiff stems in the traditional Hybrid Tea style, not just singly, but several together too. Growth is robust and vigorous ensuring a plentiful supply of scented flowers throughout the season on an imposing bush with tough leathery foliage and very good resistance to diseases. 95cms.

Named after Alfred Wainwright, best known for his famous hand written and hand-drawn Pictorial Guides to the Lakeland Fells.

Seventh Heaven

(Fryfantasy) 2003 In many ways this is almost the perfect Hybrid Tea with heavenly scented blooms of rich apricot-orange, that are so bright they sparkle. They are elegantly formed, camellia like, with layer upon layer of petals and carried in profusion on a vigorous growing bush of medium height. This is a top-performer, good in all weathers and a great all rounder with an excellent ability to fend off disease. Grows to 90cms



Grand Amore

Dedicated to love, this bright red rose refuses to fade. Grande Amore is a dark green and bushy shrub that is also extremely healthy,

winning the ADR award for 2005. Stunning as the feature of a formal bed these scented flowers on long stems make it a wonderful rose for bouquets. Grows to 80cm.

Cloud Nine

(Fryextra) 2003 Gorgeous blooms abound on this heavyweight HT that is extremely vigorous and tough. It is laden with large, classically structured flowers of bright glowing pink that have a superb fragrance. An easy growing, trouble free variety, that is certain to provide a first class display. Grows to 110cms.



Keep Smiling

In our opinion the best yellow Hybrid Tea.

(Fryflorida) 2004 An abundance of gorgeous scented blooms of bright golden yellow that are non-fading and produced on a powerhouse of a plant that provides an astonishing display all summer long. This rose really is "sunshine on a plant"! It is not only tough and easy to grow, but extremely healthy too. Grows to 95cms.



Golden Fairy Tale

The floriferous shrub produces fragrant old fashioned yellow flowers on upright stems. This robust yellow rose boasts of exceptionally disease resistant dark green foliage and has received Gold and Silver awards in international competitions. Grows to 90 cm.

Kings Macc

(Frydisco) 2002 *Anyone who says modern roses have no perfume should try this one!* The flowers are plentiful and each one is a stunning, classically formed beauty in a blend of gold, apricot and cream – and the scent is just sensational! Growth is vigorous with dark green foliage that has splendid disease resilience. This is a rare gem that has proved hugely popular. It is named to commemorate the quincentenary – the 500th anniversary of the King's School in Macclesfield, England. Grows to 90cms.
